D&T - Cushions



accurate	Neat and correct, with the right shape, size, pattern and with no mistakes.
appliqué	A type of textile art where small pieces of cloth are sewn or glued onto a larger piece to make a design.
cross-stitch	A two-stitch style of sewing which forms a cross pattern.
cushion	A soft, stuffed shape made of fabric used to make sitting more comfortable.
embellish	To add decorative details or features to something.
fabric	A natural or man-made woven or knitted material that is made from plant fibres, animal fur or synthetic material.
patch	A piece of fabric sewn onto a larger piece, sometimes for decoration and sometimes to cover a hole in the material underneath.
running stitch	A basic sewing stitch made in a straight line with spaces between stitches.
seam	The line where two pieces of fabric are sewn together.
template	A tool used to make copies of a shape or to cut a material accurately, such as a biscuit cutter.
stuffing	Soft material used to fill cushions and stuffed toys.









Remember to tie a knot in the thread so that the stitches stay secure and do not come undone!
