## Craft along with us! - you will need:

- Squares of paper, coloured, plain doesn't matter!
- Double-sided tape or glue stick
- Watercolour paints, brushes, water pot, white cartridge paper.
- Scissors

#### Optional (If you have these items to hand, grab if you can!)

- Baking paper
- Old books that are falling apart and ready for the bin!
- Paper bags (8 the same size)

## An idea for EYFS: Colour explosion trees!

- Relate to colour learning identifying colours, noticing mixing.
- Exploring a new technique paint scraping, on-trend and very easy.
- Can be applied onto pre cut shapes or work on large pieces to cut out later.
   Could be produced collaboratively.
- Decorate shapes. For example, wrap tree shapes with yarn and beads.



## An idea for KS1: Watercolour resist snowflakes

- Practise cutting skills.
  Circles cut from baking paper which then are folded into eighths, before finally cutting out random shapes to make snowflakes.
- Wet thick paper, drop on watery paint, watch colours mix and blend!
- Lay cut snowflakes on the wet painted surface and leave them!!
- Allow to completely dry before peeling off the snowflakes.
- Could draw or collage on, decorate, or repeat the cutting stage to make pretty coloured snowflakes.



## An idea for KS2: Print collages

- Fun way to explore printmaking and learning more about print qualities of different materials.
- Creating textural qualities.
- Trying out composition and what makes something visually appealing. Rule of three (or odd numbers).
- Could be a wrapping paper design.
