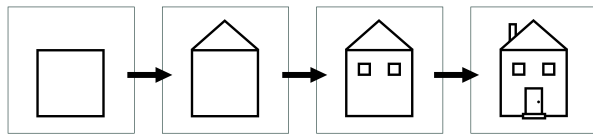
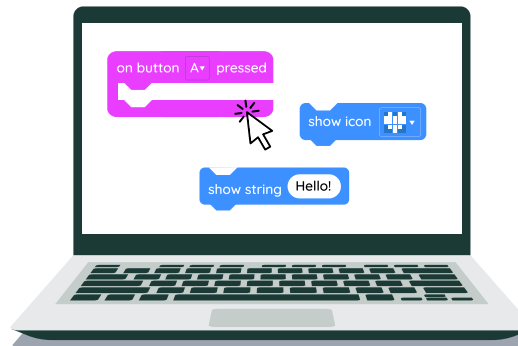


### algorithm



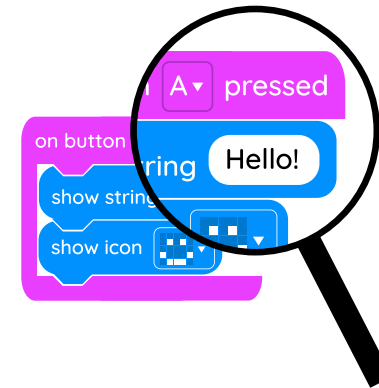
A set of steps to solve a problem or complete a task.

### block coding



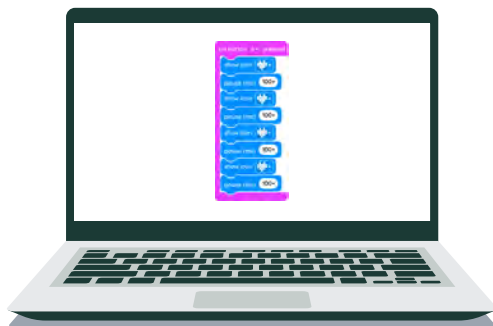
Creating code using visual blocks that fit together like a puzzle.

### debug



Finding and fixing errors in your code.

### program



A complete set of coded instructions that tell a computer what to do.

### programming



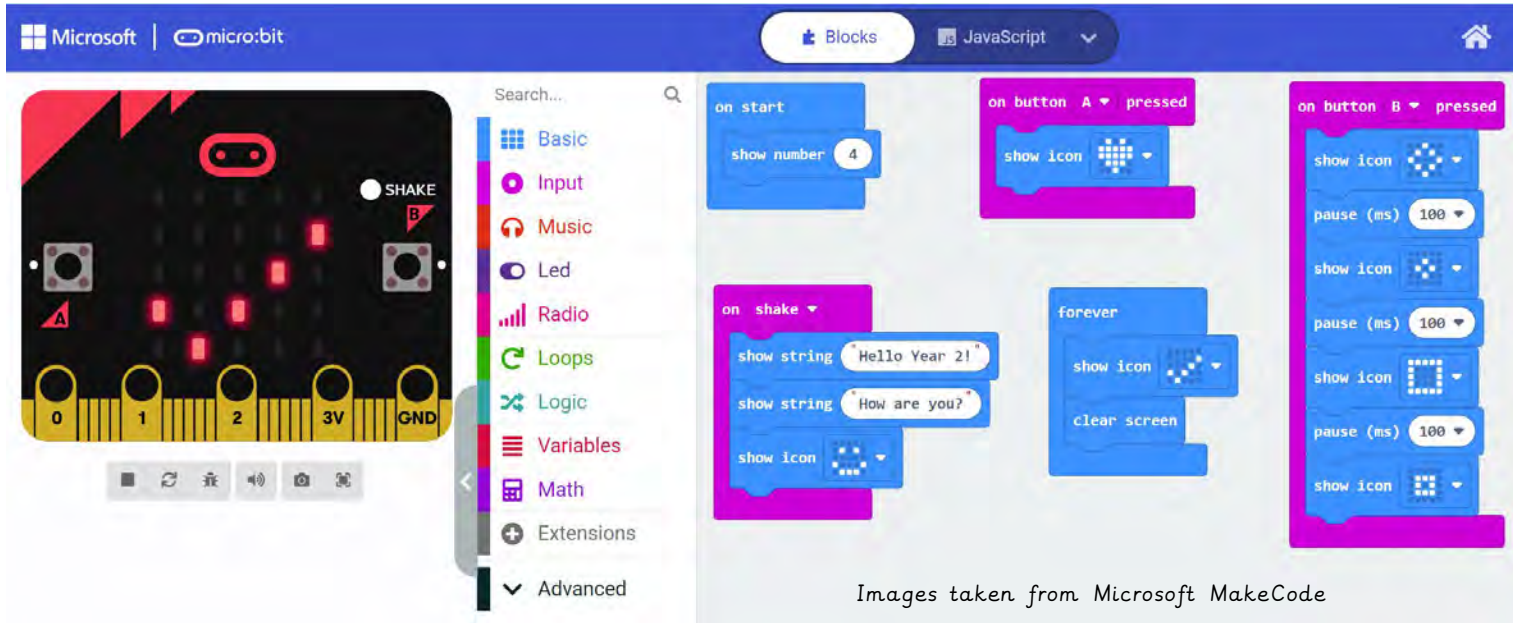
Writing instructions that a computer can follow.

### sequence

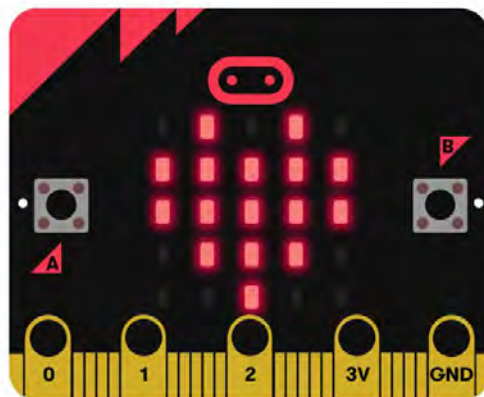


Putting steps in the correct order.

MakeCode is a block coding programme where you create instructions for a computer by dragging and dropping blocks together.



This is a micro:bit and it lets you see how your code will work.
